

MA in English Recommended Timeline

First Year

Fall

ENGL 6480 + two additional ENGL courses (9 credit hours)
WRTG 7480 (for students teaching WRTG 2010)
Consult DGS about spring courses and the foreign language requirement

Spring

Three courses (9 credit hours)
Select MA essay advisor

Note:

In the first year, MA students should take at least two literary history courses and satisfy at least one period requirement (either pre-1700 or 1700-1900). They should also either satisfy the foreign language requirement or plan to do so in Fall of the second year.

Second Year

Fall

Two courses (6 credit hours)
Draft MA essay
Consult Graduate Advisor about applying for graduation

Spring

Two courses (6 credit hours)
Complete and submit MA essay (due the second Friday after spring break)
Participate in the MA symposium

Note:

Funded students must register for 9 credit hours each semester to qualify for the tuition benefit program. ENGL 6980 (Faculty Consultation) should be taken to make up the deficit in any semester in which a student is registered for fewer than 9 credit hours.
